The elders have no duty to report child abuse under the child abuse reporting law. Whether others who have knowledge main a report or pursue the matter legally is a personal decision. We explained the Society's policy of confidentiality and directed the elders to contact the Legal Department if they are subpoonned. We had no legal objection to the elders handling this matter as they would any other case of serious wrongdoing. The elders should refer to the Awate! issues on child whose (6-2-82, 1-2-2-85, 1-2-2-86, 10-1-33) in giving appropriate spiritual assistance to the family. Positive floors should be taken to prevent further abuse. The elders should assistance to the family.	The elders have a duty to report child abuse under the child abuse reporting law. They thould speak to the offender directly and find out if he is willing to turn himself m. If he is unwilling, there may be someone else who has knowledge of the abuse who will make a report. If no one who has knowledge of the abuse who will make a report, two elders should make a sagonymous phones report from a neutral location, such as a phone booth. They should keep a written record of who made the call, to whom it was made, the date and time of the call, and other pertinent factors. This record should then be signed by the two elders and placed in coagregation files as proof that a report of child abuse was made in compliance with the law. We explained the Society's policy of confidentiality and directed the elders to contact the Legal Department if they are subpocused. We had no legal objection to the elders handling his matter as they would any other case of senous wrongdoing. The elders should refer to the Amolte's larges or child abuse (5-72-87, 1-22-85, 10-1-83) in giving appropriate spiritual assistance to the family.

(Note: if the accusation involves child sexual abuse and the victim is currently a minor, the elders should contact the branch office before arranging a meeting with the child and the alleged abuser.) If the accuser or the accused is unwilling to meet with the elders or if the accused continues to deny the accusation of a single witness and the wrongdoing is not established, the elders will leave matters in Jehovah's hands.
